Romans 6:23

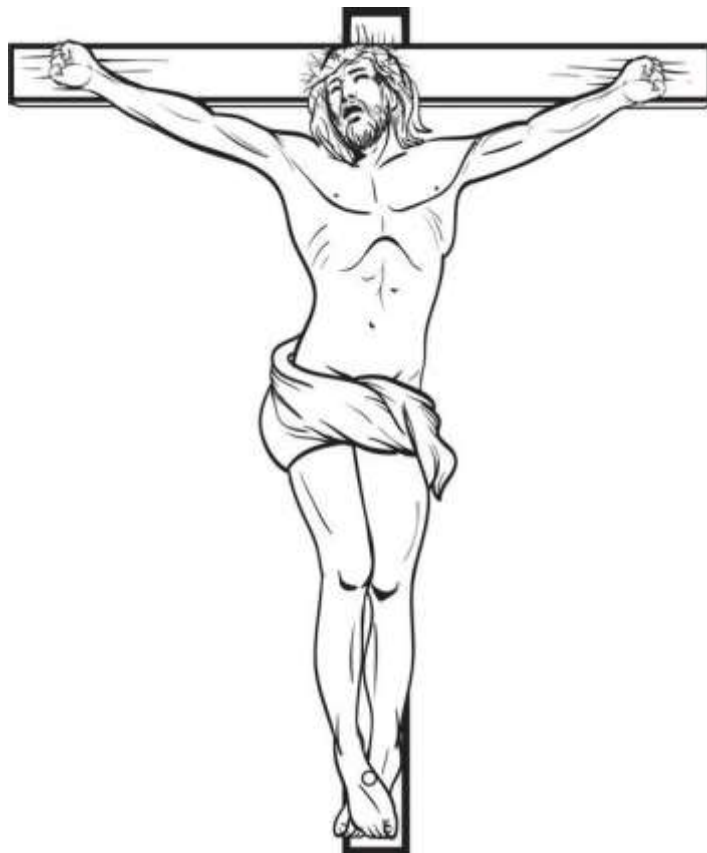
For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is

And be ye kind one to another

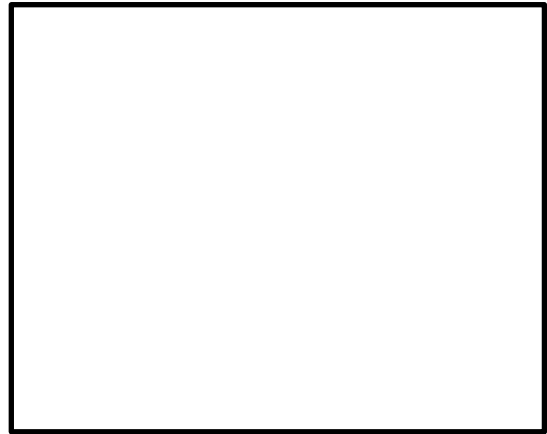
John 13:34
